(1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, it is notified for general information and guidance of all concerned that a person, who has passed the qualifying examination and is eligible for admission only to the corresponding next higher examination as an ex-student or an external candidate, shall be examined in accordance with the syllabus of such next higher examination in force at the time of such examination in such subjects, papers or combination of papers in which students from University Departments or Colleges are to be examined by the University.

Subject : Examinations leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) (Three Year Degree Course-Semester Pattern), Direciton, 2010.

Whereas, University Grants Commission, New Delhi vide D.O.No.F-2/2008/(XI Plan), Dtd.31 Jan.2008 regarding new initiatives under the 11th Plan – Academic Reforms in the University has suggested for improving quality of higher education and to initiate the Academic Reform at the earliest.

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council while considering the above letter in its meeting held on 30.4.2008, vide item No.55 has resolved to refer the same to Dean's Committee, and the Dean's Committee in its meeting held on 19.07.2008 has decided to refer the matter to all Board of Studies.

AND

Whereas the recommendations of various Board of Studies in the faculty of Science regarding Upgradation and Revision of various syllabi and introduction and implementation of Semester Pattern Examination System at under graduate level was considered by the faculty of Science in its meeting held on 7.12.2009 and constituted a Committee of all Chairmen of Board of Studies and one member nominated by Chairmen of respective B.O.S. under the Chairmanship of Dean of faculty to decide the policy decision regarding semester pattern examination system.

AND

Whereas, the faculty of Science in its emergent meeting held on 11th May, 2010 vide item No.26, has considered, accepted and recommended to Academic Council, the policy decision regarding introduction of Semester pattern and the draft syllabi of B.Sc. Part-I (Semester-I & II) along with draft ordinance and other details. The recommendations of the faculty was approved by the Academic Council in its emergent meeting held on 28.5.2010, vide item No.35 D).

AND

Whereas, Ordinance No.143 in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) is in existence in the University as per annual pattern examination system.

AND

Whereas, new scheme of examination as per semester pattern is to be implemented from the Academic Session 2010-11 for Semester-I & onwards which is regulated by an Ordinance and framing of an Ordinance for the above examination is likely to take some time.

AND

Whereas, the admission of students in the semester pattern at B.Sc. Part-I (Semester-I) are to be made in the Academic Session 2010-11.

Now, therefore, I, Dr. Kamal Singh, Vice Chancellor of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, in exercise of powers conferred upon me under sub-section (8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act., 1994, do hereby direct as under:

1. This Direction may be called, "Examinations leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) (Three Year Degree Course-Semester Pattern), Direciton, 2010".
2. This direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.
3. (i) The following shall be the examination leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) in the faculty of Science-
 - (1) The विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examination
 - (2) The विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ (B.Sc. Part-II)
 - (3) The विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-३
 - (4) The

- (i) The theory examination of Semester-I & II shall be simultaneously conducted by the University at the end of Semester-II in Summer.
- (ii) The examination of Semester-III, IV, V & VI shall be conducted by the University and shall held by the end of each semester separately.
- (iii) The main examination of Semester-III & V and that of Semester-IV & VI shall be held in Winter and Summer respectively.
- (iv) The supplementary examination for Semester-I & II shall be held in Winter and that of Semester-III & V and Semester-IV & VI in Summer and Winter respectively.

That means the theory examination of all the Semesters shall be conducted by the University and shall be held as per the schedule.

5. Subject to their compliance with the provisions of this Direction and of other Ordinances in force from time to time, the following persons shall be eligible for admission to the examinations, namely:-

- (a) A student of a College who has prosecuted a regular course of study for not less than one academic year prior to that examination;
- (b) A teacher in a Educational Institution eligible under the provisions of Ordinance No.18, and
- (c) A women candidate who has not pursued a regular course of study.

Provided that in the case of the persons eligible under clauses (b) and (c) an applicant to the examination shall have attended a full course of laboratory instructions in a College in the subject in which laboratory work is prescribed. The candidate shall submit a Certificate to that effect signed by the Principal of the college.

6. (I) **The Students passing H.S.C. Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics shall offer following subjects at B.Sc. Part-I Examination.**

- (i) English and any one of the following languages Marathi, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit, and Supplementary English.
- (ii) Three optional subjects atleast one subject from the following groups be selected.

Group A :- Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry, Petro-Chemical Science, Electronics, Mathematics.

Group B :- Physics, Geology, Statistics, Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology and Geography.

The Students passing H.S.C. Examination with Chemistry and Biology shall offer following subjects:-

- (i) English and any one of the following languages. Marathi, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit and Supplementary English.
- (ii) Chemistry.
- (iii) Two optional subejcts form the following group be selected.

Group C : Botany, Zoology, Bio-Chemistry, Geography, Fisheries, Environmental Science, Microbiology , Geology, Food Science, Industrial Microbiology, Biotechnology and Appiculture.

For Vocational subjects sanctioned by U.G.C. there shall be following scheme of Combination of subjects :-

Students with Mathematics at H.S.C. Examination shall select two subjects from Group D and one from Group F.

Students passing with Biology, at H.S.C Examination. Shall select two subjects from Group E and One from Group F.

Group D : Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Electronics, Statistics Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology and Geology.

Group E : Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Micro-Biology, Geology, Geography, Environmental Science, Industrial Microbiology and Biochemistry.

Group F : Biological Techniques and Specimen Preparation. Industrial Chemistry, Instrumentation, Computer Application, Seed Technology, Industrial Fish and Fisheries, Computer Maintenance, Biotechnology and other Vocational subjects proposed by U.G.C. from time to time shall be included in Group F.

The students passing HSC examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics shall have the option of opting Bioinformatics subject with any one subject from Group-G and any one subject from Goup-H.

Group G: Botany, Zoology, Bio-Chemistry, Microbiology, Industrial Microbiology , and Biotechnology.

Group H: Chemistry, Physics, Electronics, Statistics, Geology, Mathematics and Computer Science.

(II) The students passing H.S.C. examination (M.C.V.C. stream) with technical trades mentioned in column No.2 of the following table shall be eligible for admission to the B.Sc.Part-I course in the optional subjects mentioned in column Nos. 3 of the said table as per the scheme given in Group A to H.

Subject to his/her compliance with the provisions of this Direction and other Ordinances (pertaining to Examination in General) in force from time to time, the applicant for admission, at the end of the course of study of a particular semester to an examination specified in column (1) of the table below, shall be eligible to appear at it, if,

- he/she satisfied the condition in the table and the provisions thereunder.
- he/she has prosecuted a regular course of study in a college affiliated to the University.
- he/she has in the opinion of the Principal shown the satisfactory progress in his/her studies.

1. Every examinee for the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र-५ व ६ (B.Sc.Final, Sem-V & VI), Examination shall be examined in each of the three Science subjects in which he has been examined at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ व सत्र-४ (B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & Sem-IV) Examination.

12. An examinee who is successful at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examination, may offer an additional subject mentioned in Para (6) (iii) not offered by him at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examination, on his prosecuting a regular course of study for one academic year in that subject. Such an examinee shall not be permitted to take any other examination simultaneously with the examination in the additional subjects. The fee for the additional subject shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time.

13. The Scope of the subjects of all semester opted by the students shall be as indicated in the respective syllabi from time to time. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English except for the courses in Languages.

14. The maximum marks allotted to each subject and paper and the minimum marks which an examinee must obtain in order to pass the examination shall be as per Appendices A, B, C, D, E and F appended to this Ordinance.

15. The practical examination of all semesters shall be conducted annually. That means the practical examination shall be conducted as per following schedule.

16. The scheme of awarding internal marks shall be as per Appendix-G appended with this Direction.

17. Successful examinees at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र-६ (B.Sc. Final, Sem-VI) Examination who obtain not less than 60% marks in aggregate of Sem-I, II, III, IV, V & VI Examination taken together shall be placed in the First Division, those obtaining less than 60% but not less than 45% in the Second Division, and all other successful examinees in the pass Division.

Explanation :
Division at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र-५ व ६ (B.Sc. Final, Sem-V & Sem-VI) Examination shall be declared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Science Subjects at the Sem-I, II, III, IV, V & VI Examination taken together.

18. There shall be no classification of successful examinees at the Sem-I to Sem-V Examinations.

19. An examinee successful in the minimum period prescribed for the examination, obtaining not less than 75% of the maximum marks prescribed in the subject shall be declared to have passed the examination with Distinction in the subject.

Explanation :
(1) Distinction shall be awarded only in Science Subjects including Mathematics.
(2) Distinction at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य (B.Sc. Final) Examination shall be awarded on the basis of the marks obtained at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २; विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ व ४; व विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र ५ व ६ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II; B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV, and B.Sc. Final-Sem-V & VI) Examination taken together.
(3) Distinction shall not be awarded to an examinee availing of the provision of the exemptions and compartments at any of the examination.

20. Provisions of Ordinance No18/2001 in respect of an Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in a Head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher Class) and getting Distinction in the subject and condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute NO.18, Ordinance 2001 shall apply.

21. (A) The students who have passed B.Sc.Final examination of this University or any other statutory University shall be eligible to seek admission for studying practical of any other optional subjects offered for B.Sc. Degree for simultaneous study of complete three year course for that subject in one year and to appear simultaneously for all parts of examination leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science (additional) in that subject, subject to the following condition.
An examinee shall have attended full course of laboratory instructions in a College in the subject in which laboratory work is prescribed. An examinee shall submit a certificate to that effect signed by the Principal of the College.

- (B) On securing not less than minimum marks prescribed for the subject / subjects shall be issued certificate of having passed the examination in the additional subject/subjects as the case may be.
- (C) The application for admission to the examination under (A) above shall be submitted to the Registrar not less than three months before the date of commencement of the examination."
22. As soon as possible after the examinations the Board of Examination shall publish a list of successful examinees at the B.Sc Part-I, Sem-I & II; B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV and B.Sc. Final Sem-V & VI Examinations. Such list at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य (B.Sc. Final) Examination shall be arranged in three Divisions. The names of the examinees passing the examination as a whole in the minimum prescribed period and obtaining the prescribed number of places in First or Second Division shall be arranged in Order of Merit as provided in the Examinations in General Ordinance No. 6.
23. No Person shall be admitted to B.Sc Part-I, Sem-I & II; B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV and B.Sc. Final Sem-V & VI Examinations, if he has already passed the corresponding or an equivalent examination of any other Statutory University.
24. Successful Examinees at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) and the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ व ४ (B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV) Examination shall be entitled to receive a Certificate signed by the Registrar and successful examinee at the end of विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य सत्र-६ (B.Sc. Final, Sem-VI) Examination, shall on payment of the prescribed fees, receive a Degree in the Prescribed form, signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

ORDINANCE No. 16 of 2007

The procedure for providing photo copy/ies of Answer-book/s to an examinee and the procedure for Redressal Mechanism Ordinance, 2007.

WHEREAS, it is expedient to provide "The Procedure for providing photo copy/ies of Answer book/s to the examinee and the Procedure for Redressal Mechanism" for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following ordinance.

1. This Ordinance may be called "The Procedure for providing photo copy/ies of Answer-book/s to the examinee and the Procedure for Redressal Mechanism Ordinance - 2007."
2. This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the Summer-2007 Examinations.
3. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires-
 - a) "Act" means Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994.
 - b) The "University" means the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
 - c) The "Management Council" means the Management Council constituted u/s 27 of the Act.
 - d) The "Board of Examinations" means the Board of Examinations constituted u/s 31 of the Act.
 - e) The "32(6)(a) Committee" means a committee constituted by the Board of Examinations in accordance with the provision of Clause (a) of Sub section (6) of Section 32 of the Act.
 - f) "Examinee" means an examinee who has appeared for the examination/s conducted by the University.
 - g) "Answer book/s" means the answer book/s used by an examinee for the theory paper/s of the current examination conducted by the University.
 - h) "Redressal" means the reassessment of the Answer book/s of an examinee based on the grievance put-forth regarding evaluation for which the photo copy/ies has/ have been provided by the University

PART - I

The procedure for providing photo copy/ies of Answer-book/s to the examinee.

- 4 (i) The prescribed application form (Appendix-A appended herewith) can be obtained either from the University or from the affiliated colleges at the cost prescribed by the University. This application form shall also be available on the University's website, the cost of which shall have to be paid by an examinee along with the fees prescribed for photo copy/ies.
- (ii) The prescribed application form shall have to be filled and signed by the applicant examinee him/herself. The application form should be submitted to the confidential section of the University within fifteen days from the date of the declaration of general result of the relevant examination. Late or incomplete application form in any respect shall be rejected and the fees paid for the same shall not be refunded on any pretext.

- (iii) The Photo Copy/ies shall be provided to an examinee on payment of non-refundable fee prescribed by the University. The payment should be made either in cash or by D.D. drawn in favour of "The Registrar, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati."
 - (iv) An examinee may demand photo copy/ies of maximum **two theory** papers only.
 - (v) The photo copy/ies of answer-book/s of internal assessment, practical examination, sessional marks, viva-voce, dissertation, thesis, field work, aptitude test and entrance test etc. shall not be supplied to an examinee.
 - (vi) Any examinee, whose result has been withheld for any valid reasons/discrepancies, shall not be entitled to apply for obtaining photo copy/ies of the subjects/papers.
5. The University shall endeavour to provide photo copy/ies of Answer-book/s within **thirty days** from the due date of the submission of the application form. The delay in providing the same due to unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances shall not confer any right upon the candidate for admission to next higher class.
6. The Photo copy/ies shall be provided to the applicant examinee in person or to his/her authorised nominee recommended by the Principal of an affiliated college of the University. Nominee shall have to produce any one of the following documents for identification before the concerned officer of the University.
- a) Driving licence.
 - b) Election card
 - c) Identity card
 - d) Hall Ticket (Admission card)
- The Principal or his representative of the concerned college may also collect photo copy/ies of the answer book/s personally for early disposal of their student's process of redressal.
7. On the receipt of photo copy/ies, the applicant examinee shall be the sole custodian of it/ them and under any circumstances it/they shall not be transferred to any third person including the media for the trial or for any other purpose/s whatsoever. Since the mechanism for redressal is provided to him/her under this ordinance with a view to bring transparency & credibility in the examination system, it is the duty of the applicant examinee to refrain himself/herself from misusing this additional facility so that it will not jeopardize the reputation of the University.
- Any deviation in following the aforementioned procedure by the applicant examinee shall be construed as an unfair act on the part of him/her and shall make him/her liable for punishment by the university.
8. It is the duty of the concerned officer of the Confidential Section to ascertain that the identity of the examiner/s, moderator/s shall not be disclosed and the photo copy/ies of assessed answer book/s to be provided to the applicant examinee/s, shall be bereft of such identity.
9. If an examinee is found guilty of any misuse of photo copy/ies, he/she shall attract the provisions of Section 32(6)(a) of the Act, and shall be liable for the punishment ranging from debarring him/her from appearing at any examination to confiscation of his/her degree/s conferred.

PART-II

The Procedure for Redressal Mechanism

10. On receipt of photo copy/ies of desired answer book/s, if the examinee is not satisfied with the marks awarded to him/her, he/she may apply for redressal to the University in the prescribed form.
11. The prescribed application form (Appendix-B appended herewith) can be obtained either from the University or from the affiliated colleges at the cost prescribed by the University. This application form shall also be available on the University's website the

cost of which shall have to be paid by an examinee along with the fees prescribed for the redressal mechanism.

12. An examinee shall have to furnish all information clearly in the application form, provided as per Appendix-B.
13. The prescribed application form duly filled in and signed by an applicant examinee himself/herself shall be submitted to the confidential Section of the University within **ten days** from the prescribed date of the collection of photo copy/ies of answer book/s along with the following documents-
 - a) Receipt of non-refundable fees as prescribed by the University to be paid in cash or Demand Draft drawn in favour of The Registrar, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati.
 - b) The certified photo copy of the marksheet.

Late and /or incomplete application form in any respect shall be rejected and fees paid for the same shall not be refunded on any pretext.

14. Appointment of Examiners for reassessment shall be made from the list of examiners recommended by 32(5)(a) committee and approved by the Board of Examinations. The answer book/s for redressal shall be reassessed by the valuers other than original valuer / moderator who had valued/moderated them initially.
15. The Subjectwise / Paperwise total lot of answer books for reassessment shall be masked, concealing all the marks and / of the identity of an examinee as well as the marks awarded by the original examiner in accordance with the provisions of the concerned Ordinance /Scheme.
16. Answer book/s received for redressal shall be handed over to the Chief Officer, CAP Centre and he shall get the answer book/s assessed by the Subsequent examiner/s from the panel of examiners of the concerned subject and approved by the Board of Examinations. Such subsequent examiner shall not be the original examiner / moderator.

Provided further that in respect of answer books not covered in the above provision or in case of urgency, or if it is expedient; he may get the assessment done by the teacher/s from the subject expert from the University or and other University with the prior permission of the Vice-Chancellor

17. The remuneration for assessing the answer books by the subsequent examiner/s appointed as per para 16 above shall be Rs.25/- per paper and shall be entitled for T.A. & D.A. as per the rates, laid down in Central Assessment Programme System.
18. If the marks awarded by the subsequent examiner vary/deviate on either side, by less than 4 percent (including 4 percent) of the total marks prescribed, determined on the basis of marks given in the original result then the original marks of the applicant examinee shall remain unchanged and "no-change" result shall be communicated to him/her by the University."
19. If the marks awarded by the subsequent examiner vary/deviate on either side by more than 5 percent (including 5 percent) of the total marks prescribed and less than 15 percent (including 15 percent) of the total marks prescribed, determined on the basis of marks given in the original result then the original marks of the applicant examinee shall be changed and marks awarded by subsequent examiner shall be awarded to the examinee.
20. If the marks awarded by the subsequent examiner vary/deviate on either side by more than 16 percent (including 16 percent) of the total marks prescribed then the answerbook/s shall be reassessed by the second subsequent examiner and the mean of the higher two examiners be considered to award the marks to the examinee.

21. If there occurs any fraction in calculating percentage of marks or total marks, the fraction of mark shall be converted into next higher integer.

Provided that the marks of an examinee who has secured Pass or more marks in original evaluation, shall not get lowered in any case than the level of Pass marks after redressal in the paper concerned.

22. The change of marks after redressal, if any, shall be communicated to the applicant/s and revised statement of marks shall be given to him/her only on surrendering of his/her original statement of marks to the Asstt.Registrar(Exam.) of the University.
23. The whole process of redressal shall be completed as far as possible within a period of forty days from the due date of the receipt of application for the redressal.
24. The photo copy/ies of the answer books after redressal shall not be provided to any examinee in any case/reason.
25. After the preparation of the result/s the cases of redressal having deviation on either side by more than 25 percent of the total marks prescribed shall be referred to 32(6)(a) committee to verify and ascertain the negligence if any, on the part of examiner/s or moderator/s. Such case/s shall be recommended to Board of Examinations for necessary action. The decision of the Board of Examinations regarding the same shall be final.
26. After redressal if there is a change in the result of an examinee, he/she may be permitted, if eligible for seeking admission to next higher class OR avail the facility of the provision of A.T.K.T. within 10 days from the date of communication of the result to him/her. The concerned examinee shall have to seek special permission for admission from the Vice-Chancellor through the Principal of the college.

Whereas, University Grants Commission, New Delhi vide D.O.No.F-2/2008/(XI Plan), Dtd.31 Jan.2008 regarding new initiatives under the 11th Plan – Academic Reforms in the University has suggested for improving quality of higher education and to initiate the Academic Reform at the earliest.

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council while considering the above letter in its meeting held on 30.4.2008, vide item No.55 has resolved to refer the same to Dean's Committee, and the Dean's Committee in its meeting held on 19.07.2008 has decided to refer the matter to all Board of Studies.

AND

Whereas the recommendations of various Board of Studies in the faculty of Science regarding Upgradation and Revision of various syllabi and introduction and implementation of Semester Pattern Examination System at under graduate level was considered by the faculty of Science in its meeting held on 7.12.2009 and constituted a Committee of all Chairmen of Board of Studies and one member nominated by Chairmen of respective B.O.S. under the Chairmanship of Dean of faculty to decide the policy decision regarding semester pattern examination system.

AND

Whereas, the faculty of Science in its emergent meeting held on 11th May, 2010 vide item No.26, has considered, accepted and recommended to Academic Council, the policy decision regarding introduction of Semester pattern and the draft syllabi of B.Sc. Part-I (Semester-I & II) along with draft ordinance and other details. The recommendations of the faculty was approved by the Academic Council in its emergent meeting held on 28.5.2010, vide item No.35 D).

AND

Whereas, Ordinance No.143 in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) is in existence in the University as per annual pattern examination system.

AND

Whereas, new scheme of examination as per semester pattern is to be implemented from the Academic Session 2010-11 for Semester-I & onwards which is regulated by an Ordinance and framing of an Ordinance for the above examination is likely to take some time.

AND

Whereas, the admission of students in the semester pattern at B.Sc. Part-I (Semester-I) are to be made in the Academic Session 2010-11.

Now, therefore, I, Dr. Kamal Singh, Vice Chancellor of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, in exercise of powers conferred upon me under sub-section (8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act., 1994, do hereby direct as under:

1. This Direction may be called, "Examinations leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) (Three Year Degree Course-Semester Pattern), Direciton, 2010".
2. This direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.
3. (i) The following shall be the examination leading to the Degree of विज्ञान स्नातक (Bachelor of Science) in the faculty of Science-
 - (1) The विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examination
 - (2) The विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ (B.Sc. Part-II)
 - (3) The विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-३
 - (4) The

- (i) The theory examination of Semester-I & II shall be simultaneously conducted by the University at the end of Semester-II in Summer.
- (ii) The examination of Semester-III, IV, V & VI shall be conducted by the University and shall held by the end of each semester separately.
- (iii) The main examination of Semester-III & V and that of Semester-IV & VI shall be held in Winter and Summer respectively.
- (iv) The supplementary examination for Semester-I & II shall be held in Winter and that of Semester-III & V and Semester-IV & VI in Summer and Winter respectively.

That means the theory examination of all the Semesters shall be conducted by the University and shall be held as per the schedule.

5. Subject to their compliance with the provisions of this Direction and of other Ordinances in force from time to time, the following persons shall be eligible for admission to the examinations, namely:-

- (a) A student of a College who has prosecuted a regular course of study for not less than one academic year prior to that examination;
- (b) A teacher in a Educational Institution eligible under the provisions of Ordinance No.18, and
- (c) A women candidate who has not pursued a regular course of study.

Provided that in the case of the persons eligible under clauses (b) and (c) an applicant to the examination shall have attended a full course of laboratory instructions in a College in the subject in which laboratory work is prescribed. The candidate shall submit a Certificate to that effect signed by the Principal of the college.

6. (I) **The Students passing H.S.C. Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics shall offer following subjects at B.Sc. Part-I Examination.**

- (i) English and any one of the following languages Marathi, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit, and Supplementary English.
- (ii) Three optional subjects atleast one subject from the following groups be selected.

Group A :- Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry, Petro-Chemical Science, Electronics, Mathematics.

Group B :- Physics, Geology, Statistics, Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology and Geography.

The Students passing H.S.C. Examination with Chemistry and Biology shall offer following subjects:-

- (i) English and any one of the following languages. Marathi, Hindi, Urdu, Sanskrit and Supplementary English.
- (ii) Chemistry.
- (iii) Two optional subejcts form the following group be selected.

Group C : Botany, Zoology, Bio-Chemistry, Geography, Fisheries, Environmental Science, Microbiology , Geology, Food Science, Industrial Microbiology, Biotechnology and Appiculture.

For Vocational subjects sanctioned by U.G.C. there shall be following scheme of Combination of subjects :-

Students with Mathematics at H.S.C. Examination shall select two subjects from Group D and one from Group F.

Students passing with Biology, at H.S.C Examination. Shall select two subjects from Group E and One from Group F.

Group D : Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Electronics, Statistics Computer Science, Computer Application, Information Technology and Geology.

Group E : Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Micro-Biology, Geology, Geography, Environmental Science, Industrial Microbiology and Biochemistry.

Group F : Biological Techniques and Specimen Preparation. Industrial Chemistry, Instrumentation, Computer Application, Seed Technology, Industrial Fish and Fisheries, Computer Maintenance, Biotechnology and other Vocational subjects proposed by U.G.C. from time to time shall be included in Group F.

The students passing HSC examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics shall have the option of opting Bioinformatics subject with any one subject from Group-G and any one subject from Goup-H.

Group G: Botany, Zoology, Bio-Chemistry, Microbiology, Industrial Microbiology , and Biotechnology.

Group H: Chemistry, Physics, Electronics, Statistics, Geology, Mathematics and Computer Science.

(II) The students passing H.S.C. examination (M.C.V.C. stream) with technical trades mentioned in column No.2 of the following table shall be eligible for admission to the B.Sc.Part-I course in the optional subjects mentioned in column Nos. 3 of the said table as per the scheme given in Group A to H.

- he/she satisfied the condition in the table and the provisions thereunder.
- he/she has prosecuted a regular course of study in a college affiliated to the University.

1. Every examinee for the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र-५ व ६ (B.Sc.Final, Sem-V & VI), Examination shall be examined in each of the three Science subjects in which he has been examined at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ व सत्र-४ (B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & Sem-IV) Examination.

12. An examinee who is successful at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examination, may offer an additional subject mentioned in Para (6) (iii) not offered by him at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examination, on his prosecuting a regular course of study for one academic year in that subject. Such an examinee shall not be permitted to take any other examination simultaneously with the examination in the additional subjects. The fee for the additional subject shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time.

13. The Scope of the subjects of all semester opted by the students shall be as indicated in the respective syllabi from time to time. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English except for the courses in Languages.

14. The maximum marks allotted to each subject and paper and the minimum marks which an examinee must obtain in order to pass the examination shall be as per Appendices A, B, C, D, E and F appended to this Ordinance.

15. The practical examination of all semesters shall be conducted annually. That means the practical examination shall be conducted as per following schedule.

16. The scheme of awarding internal marks shall be as per Appendix-G appended with this Direction.

17. Successful examinees at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र-६ (B.Sc. Final, Sem-VI) Examination who obtain not less than 60% marks in aggregate of Sem-I, II, III, IV, V & VI Examination taken together shall be placed in the First Division, those obtaining less than 60% but not less than 45% in the Second Division, and all other successful examinees in the pass Division.

Explanation :

Division at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र-५ व ६ (B.Sc. Final, Sem-V & Sem-VI) Examination shall be declared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Science Subjects at the Sem-I, II, III, IV, V & VI Examination taken together.

18. There shall be no classification of successful examinees at the Sem-I to Sem-V Examinations.

19. An examinee successful in the minimum period prescribed for the examination, obtaining not less than 75% of the maximum marks prescribed in the subject shall be declared to have passed the examination with Distinction in the subject.

Explanation :

- (1) Distinction shall be awarded only in Science Subjects including Mathematics.
- (2) Distinction at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य (B.Sc. Final) Examination shall be awarded on the basis of the marks obtained at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २; विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ व ४; व विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य, सत्र ५ व ६ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II; B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV, and B.Sc. Final-Sem-V & VI) Examination taken together.
- (3) Distinction shall not be awarded to an examinee availing of the provision of the exemptions and compartments at any of the examination.

20. Provisions of Ordinance No18/2001 in respect of an Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in a Head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher Class) and getting Distinction in the subject and condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute NO.18, Ordinance 2001 shall apply.

21. (A) The students who have passed B.Sc.Final examination of this University or any other statutory University shall be eligible to seek admission for studying practical of any other optional subjects offered for B.Sc. Degree for simultaneous study of complete three year course for that subject in one year and to appear simultaneously for all parts of examination leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science (additional) in that subject, subject to the following condition.
An examinee shall have attended full course of laboratory instructions in a College in the subject in which laboratory work is prescribed. An examinee shall submit a certificate to that effect signed by the Principal of the College.

- (B) On securing not less than minimum marks prescribed for the subject / subjects shall be issued certificate of having passed the examination in the additional subject/subjects as the case may be.
- (C) The application for admission to the examination under (A) above shall be submitted to the Registrar not less than three months before the date of commencement of the examination."
22. As soon as possible after the examinations the Board of Examination shall publish a list of successful examinees at the B.Sc Part-I, Sem-I & II; B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV and B.Sc. Final Sem-V & VI Examinations. Such list at the विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य (B.Sc. Final) Examination shall be arranged in three Divisions. The names of the examinees passing the examination as a whole in the minimum prescribed period and obtaining the prescribed number of places in First or Second Division shall be arranged in Order of Merit as provided in the Examinations in General Ordinance No. 6.
23. No Person shall be admitted to B.Sc Part-I, Sem-I & II; B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV and B.Sc. Final Sem-V & VI Examinations, if he has already passed the corresponding or an equivalent examination of any other Statutory University.
24. Successful Examinees at the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-१, सत्र-१ व २ (B.Sc. Part-I, Sem-I & II) and the विज्ञान स्नातक भाग-२, सत्र-३ व ४ (B.Sc. Part-II, Sem-III & IV) Examination shall be entitled to receive a Certificate signed by the Registrar and successful examinee at the end of विज्ञान स्नातक अन्त्य सत्र-६ (B.Sc. Final, Sem-VI) Examination, shall on payment of the prescribed fees, receive a Degree in the Prescribed form, signed by the Vice-Chancellor.





Subject :- Reassessment of answer-book/s of examinees without obtaining photocopy/ies of answer-book/s on their demand - Direction 2023

Whereas, the examinees are permitted to apply for reassessment of answerbooks after obtaining Photocopy/ies of Answerbooks as per Ordinance No. 16 of 2007 and also the examinees are permitted to apply for reassessment of answerbooks of examinees without obtaining Photocopy of Answerbooks as per Direction No. 66 of 2010 (main Direction) read with Direction No. 11 of 2015, Direction No. 24 of 2015 and Direction No. 22 of 2016.

AND

Whereas, the Board of Examination and Evaluation vide Item No. 13 (क) in its meeting held on 5/2/2019 taking into account the decision of the Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai, Nagpur Bench, Nagpur vide writ petition no. 4564 of 2018 dated 4/9/2018, striking down Direction No. 24 of 2015, accepted to exclude the said Direction.

AND

Whereas, the main Direction No. 66 of 2010 has been amended time to time by the Directions mentioned above, and recently the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 came into force, it is necessary to issue a fresh Direction consolidately all these Directions by including the decision of the Board of Examination & Evaluation.

AND

Whereas, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has accepted the decision of Board of Examination & Evaluation, u/s 12(7) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016, on behalf of the Academic Council and Management Council, as the matter is to be regulated by prescribing the ordinance.

AND

Whereas, the procedure of prescribing the ordinance u/s 74 of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016, is time consuming, hence the Direction No. 16 of 2019 was issued u/s 12(8) of the Act, which has been lapsed on completion of its 6 months period, under this section 12(8) of the Act.

AND

Whereas, the applications of Reassessment are to be received from students hence the fresh Direction u/s 12(8) of Act is to be issued.

Therefore, I, Prof. (Dr.) Pramod Yeole, I/c Vice-Chancellor, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati in exercise of powers conferred upon me under Sub-section (8) of Section 12 of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016, hereby issue the Direction as under :-

1. This Direction may be called "Reassessment of answerbook/s of examinees without obtaining photocopy/ies of answer-book/s on their demand- Direction-2023"
2. This Direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.
3. In this Direction, unless the context otherwise requires -
 - (a) "Act" means Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016
 - (b) The "University" means the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
 - (c) The "48(5)(a) Committee" means a committee constituted by the Board of Examinations and Evaluation in accordance with the provision of Clause (a) of Sub-Section (5) of Section 48 of the Act 2016.

(d) "Direction" means a Direction issued by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor under Section 12(8) of the Act.

(e) "Examinee" means an examinee who has appeared for the examinations/s conducted by the University.

(f) "Answer book/s" means the answer book/s used by an examinee for the theory paper/s of the current examination conducted by the University.

(g) "Reassessment" means the reassessment of the Answer book(s) of examinees without obtaining photocopy/ies of Answer books on their demand from the University.

4. (i) The examinee may seek for re-assessment of his/her Answer book/s without obtaining the photocopy/ies of Answer book/s in maximum two subjects /theory papers. The examinee availing facility under this Direction shall not be eligible to avail any facility of ordinance No. 16 of 2007 in any case, even if, he/she applied for reassessment of only one paper, under this Direction.

And also the examinee availing facility of Ordinance No. 16 of 2007 only for one paper shall not be eligible to avail facility of this direction in any case.

(ii) The examinee shall have to apply only by making online application on the University Website and take out hard copy of the same. The hard copy of application form shall be submitted in the Confidential Section of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University within 15 days from the date of publication of declaration of general result of that examination alongwith the following documents :-

- a) Receipt of Non-refundable fees of Rs. 200/- per paper to be paid in cash or Demand Draft drawn in favour of the The Finance & Accounts Officer, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University or by online payment system.
- b) Original mark sheet of concerning examination.

Late and /or incomplete application form in any respect shall be rejected and fees paid for the same shall not be refunded on any pretext.

(iii) Any examinee whose result has been kept withheld for any discrepancies on his/ her part, shall not be entitled to avail the facility of reassessment under this Direction.

5. Appointment of Examiners for reassessment shall be made from the list of examiners recommended by 48 (3)(a) committee and approved by the Board of Examination and Evaluation. The answerbook/s for reassessment shall be reassessed by the valuers other than original valuer who had valued them initially.
6. The Subjectwise / Paperwise total lot of answer-book/s for reassessment shall be masked, concealing all the marks and/ of the identity of an examinee as well as the marks awarded by the original examiner in accordance with the provisions of the concerned Ordinance/ Scheme.
7. Answer-book/s received for reassessment shall be handed over to the Chief Office, CAP Centre and he shall get the answer book/s assessed by the Subsequent examiner/s from the panel of examiners of the concerned subject and approved by the Board of Examination and Evaluation. Such subsequent examiner shall not be the original examiner.

Provided further that in respect of answer-books not covered in the above provision or in case of urgency, or if it is expedient; he may get the assessment done by the teacher's from the subject expert from the University or and other University with the prior permission of the Vice-Chancellor.

8. The remuneration for reassessing the answer book/s by the examiner/s shall be prescribed by the University and shall be entitled for T.A. & D.A. as per the rates, laid down in Central Assessment Programme System.
9. If the marks awarded by the subsequent examiner vary/deviate on either side, by less than 4 percent (including 4 percent) of the total marks prescribed, determined on the basis of marks given in the original result then the original marks of the applicant examinee shall remain unchanged and "no-change" result shall be communicated to him/her by the University.
10. If the marks awarded by the subsequent examiner vary/deviate on either side by more than 5 percent (including 5 percent) of the total marks prescribed and less than 15 percent (including 15 percent) of the total marks prescribed, determined on the basis of marks given in the original result then the original marks of the applicant examinee shall be changed and marks awarded by subsequent examiner shall be awarded to the examinee.
11. If the marks awarded by the subsequent examiner vary/deviate on either side by more than 16 percent (including 16 percent) of the total marks prescribed then the answerbook/s shall be reassessed by the second subsequent examiner and the mean of the higher two examiners be considered to award the marks to the examinee.
12. If there occurs any fraction in calculating percentage of marks or total marks, the fraction of mark shall be converted into next higher integer.
Provided that the marks of an examinee who has secured Pass or more marks in original evaluation, shall not get lowered in any case than the level of Pass marks after redressal in the paper concerned.
provided further that if the examinee has appeared in succeeding examination in the subject/s or paper/s in which he/she has applied for redressal or reassessment and the result of redressal or reassessment is declared later-on, the examinee shall be awarded the higher marks scored by him/her either in reassessment or in succeeding examination.
13. The change of marks after reassessment, if any, shall be communicated to the applicant/s and revised statement of marks shall be given to him/her by the Asstt. Registrar (Exam.) of the University.
14. The whole process of reassessment shall be completed as far as possible, ordinarily within a period of sixty days from the due date of the receipt of application for the reassessment.
15. After the preparation of the result/s the cases of reassessment having deviation on either side by more than 25 percent of the total marks prescribed shall be referred to 48(5)(a) committee to verify and ascertain the negligence if any, on the part of examiner/s. Such case/s shall be recommended to Board of Examination and Evaluation for necessary action. The decision of the Board of Examination and Evaluation regarding the same shall be final.
16. After reassessment if there is a change in the result of an examinee, he/she may be permitted, if eligible for seeking admission to next higher class OR avail the facility of the provision of A.T.K.T. within 10 days from the date of communication of the result to

him/her, The concerned examinee shall have to seek special permission for admission from the Vice-Chancellor through the Principal of the college.

Provided that, if the examinee has applied for reassessment, he/she shall be permitted to seek provisional admission to next higher class. After reassessment, if he/she is eligible for admission, his/her admission shall be confirmed. In case, if he/she is not eligible for admission to next higher class, his/her provisional admission shall stand cancelled and the fees paid by the candidate shall be refund.

17. The Direction No. 16/2019 stands lapsed.

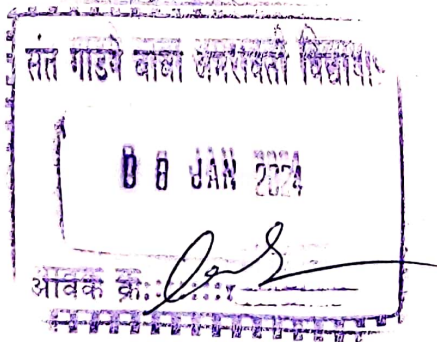

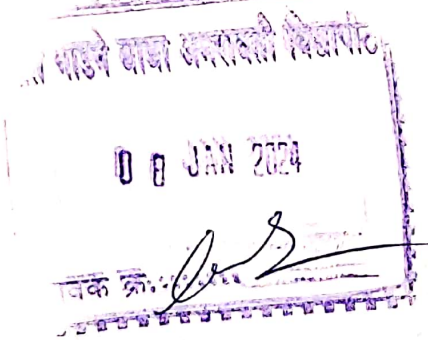

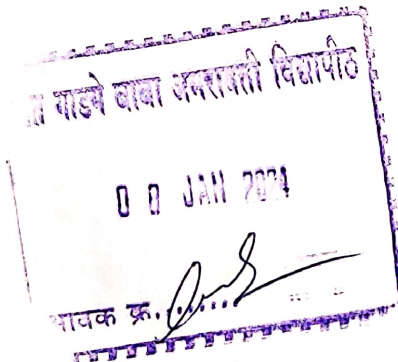
