2022-23

In the academic session 2022-23, total 1030 students of the college are admitted to the Induction Programme. As per the guidelines of the University at the beginning of session 2022, all the academic, administrative activities of the college and the various activities implemented by the college and the university for the students admitted in the first year and various government schemes and educational concessions are informed to students in an induction programme conducted during 26th of July 2022 to 31st of July 2022. A motivational program was held to inform about the new education policy on 17th September 2022. Choice Based Credit System under **National Education Policy 2020** training workshop was organized. As a resource person Dr. Sangeeta Javanjal guided and 79 professors from different five colleges participated in this workshop.

Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University, 2022 Yuva Mahotsav was organized at Shri Shivaji College of Arts and Commerce Amravati from 12th October 2022 to 16th October 2022. In this festival, a total 29 students of the college participated in 17 art forms, in which Nikhil Vilhekar, a student of BA Part III secured the second position in the art form of Collage in the same manner Nikhil Vilhekar, a student of BA Part III participated in **State Level Youth festival** organized by Nehru Yuva Kendra, He was also got selected for National Youth festival. On 12 December 2022 at P.R.POTE College of Engineering and Management Amravati in **Research Avishkar 2022** district level invention competition organized by Sant Gadgebaba Amravati University Amravati. Atharva Jalatare and Pranav Rithe students of B.A. I year under the guidance of Professor Dr. Shital Rathod presented the project and received the Second Prize for their project titled, 'Bullock Carts the Saviour of Farmers'

Various committees were formed to carry out different types of educational activities, co-curricular activities and extension work in the college. Through various departments of the college, various study activities such as Unit Tests, Seminars, Group Discussions, Essay Competitions, Lectures, and Elocution competitions, Essays, Educational Visits and Tours are being carried out. Apart from this, the academic report of various Departments of the college is being presented as follows- on 11th October 2022 Department of English, BSC Part I students **Visited Badnera Railway Station**. They were taught How to make Inquiries, How to Book Tickets, how to read train time tables etc. For the students of B.COM Ist the Department of English has organised Industrial visit to MIDC Badnera on 29th April 2023 to inculcate innovation in Entrepreneurship. In which the students understood all information required for the management processes necessary for the spice industry, and its financial and sales management too.

"Geography Day" was celebrated on 14th January, 2023 by the Department of Geography on the occasion of Environment and Environmental Pollution. A guest lecture was organized on 01.03.23 from 6:30 to 8:30 in the night; a sky viewing program was organized for the citizens of Jalu village. At that time, a lecture was organized by Mr. Praveen Gulhane, President of Marathi Science Council on Planets and Humans. The alliance of planets and the four moons of Jupiter were shown at this time. On this occasion 117 villagers enjoyed 'Akash Darshan' with a great curiosity. **"A Water and soil survey"** was conducted at Jawraon 24.03.23 in which information about water and soil was collected from every house

in the village. Total 41 students of BA Part III participated in the survey on 25.03.23. On 06.03.23 village map was prepared at Jasapur with the help of flat board, total 27 students of BA Part III participated in this activity.



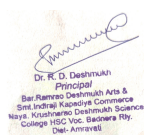

Also on 24.03.2022 A lecture on 'Personality Development and Competitive Exam' by prof. Ajay Wankhade was organized. 110 students participated in this. A workshop on 'Opportunities in IAS' was organized on 25.03.2022, Prof. Amol Patil guided the students.

Women Empowerment Committee organized Essay Competition on 3.1.2022, Lecture on Women Entrepreneurship: Opportunities, Government Schemes and Facilities on 8.3.2022, Yoga Training Camp for students from 5.4.2022 to 9.4.2022 was also organized. Under Sustainability professional ethics committee on 8.1.2022 Dr. A lecture on 'Gender Equality' by Daya Pandey, Indian College; Amravati was organized in which 50 students participated. Academic Report

2020-21


In the academic session 2020-2021, 1219 students are registered for post graduate courses and degree in senior college department. Due to the outbreak of Covid-19, schools and colleges have been closed for post-admitted students. As a result of this students were taught 4 courses in the department on online. "Zoom app, Google Classroom, Cisco Webex applications, was mainly used for online teaching. WhatsApp was used to send syllabus pdf, notes, and assignments to students. Some departments created course videos and taught theoretical and practical lessons to students through YouTube channels. For Internal evaluation of students Google form was used. Learning Management System software for online teaching method has been procured through the college. Also new high speed internet connection has been taken in the college. A total of Rs. 1, 29,363 has been spent for it. In this year college purchase LMS, WEBEX for online teaching & evaluation process. For this college conducted 6 days hands on training – Workshop for the teaching & non teaching staff. All the staff of college actively participated in this workshop. Apart from this, various co-curricular and co-extra-curricular activities were organized by the department in various colleges mainly through online test google form, project assignment, seminar, poster presentation, essay competition, quiz competition, nutrition month festival, and world food. Celebrating the day, arranging flowers. Students participated in Greeting Card Making, Embroidery Stitching Exhibition, Lecture on Research Methodology, Flower Arrangement and **Best Out of West** through YouTube link. Paper Presentation, Yoga and Pranayam training camp was organized by the Department of Physical Education and Sports under the FDP program in which a total of 53 trainees including students, college staff and local citizens participated. 683 students participated in the national level mathematics quiz conducted by the Department of Mathematics for post graduate students. 178 students participated in university level NET/SET guidance workshop. Essay competition was organized on 15 February 2021 in which 260 students from various colleges participated. A total of 168 students participated in the quiz competition held on February 22, 2021. Also, a national level e-conference on "Recent Mathematical Innovations and Skills in 21st Century" has been organized on 27 March 2021.

Various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities were conducted by various departments of the college. Mainly English Department conducted National Level Webinar on “Digital and Softs skills for Teaching English” was organized on September 9, 2021. On June 6, 2021, the Department of History organized an Essay Competition on "Swarajya and Fulfilling the Dream of Shivaji Maharaj". A total of 7 students submitted online essays. On 14th August 2021 by the Geography Department.

Prof. Dr. Sawan Deshmukh's a lecture on ""Wildlife and Environmental Conservation" was organized online. Department of Home Economics organized a quiz competition on “World Breastfeeding Day” on August 7, 2021 in which 190 students from various colleges participated. Nutrition Week was celebrated from September 1 to 7, 2021. A drawing, painting, greeting letter preparation competition was organized online on the topic of situation and balanced diet in the Corona era. A state level webinar on "Research writing a valuable tool" was organized by the Department of Chemistry on 19th August, 2021. On 17th September, 2021 A Webinar on "Research Profile Development and Benefits" was organized by Department of Zoology on 6th August, 2021. Lecture by Mrs. Shubhangi Gulhane, Inspector of Station, Badnera. Reading Competition by Department of Botany on 9th April, 2021 and on 20 April 2021, a picture competition was organized. College NSS has organized distribution of masks, plantation of trees, banners for Corona awareness, felicitation program on the occasion of birth anniversary of legends. Yoga demonstration camp was organized on April 9, 2021 by the Library department on the subject of government schemes and concessions for the industry. A total of 649 students participated in this on 21st June, 2021 on the occasion of World Yoga Day. A total of 649 students participated in this workshop. On 9th August 2021 Dr. Father of Librarianship. Ranganathan Jayanti was celebrated. On 18 August 2021, a one-day webinar “On Information Retrieval Techniques” was organized in which students are guided by Dr. Mohan Kherde, Director, Knowledge Resource Centre, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. 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Annual Report
2018 to 2019 & 2019-2020

For the Induction programme of academic session 2018-2019 total 1244 students are enrolled meanwhile in the session of 2019-2020, there were 1060 students enrolled. At the beginning of both the semesters, the students admitted in the first year were given information about all the academic / administrative activities of the college, various activities implemented by the college / university, government schemes and educational concessions. Various committees were constituted to implement various educational activities, extra-curricular activities and extension work in the college.

Various co-curricular and extension activities like unit tests, seminars, group discussions, essay competitions, lectures, elocution competitions, posters, educational visits and trips are being implemented through various departments of the college. Apart from this, the academic reports of various departments of the college are being presented. Department of Commerce organized a workshop on "Tally" on 18th January, 2019. On the occasion of the inauguration of the Commerce Board on 18th September 2019, Dr. Dinesh Nichat delivered a lecture on "Self-employment for commerce student" At this event students were guided to prioritize their own business by acquiring employment oriented skills. On September 27, 2019, under Industrial Skill Development, Director of Sparkle Institute , Prof Atul Mahashabde helped to conduct 3rd All India Commerce Aptitude Test.

Students from the physical department participated in NCC Camp at Bhartiya College, Amarvati. Head of the Department Prof. Dr. P. M. Deshmukh has published two research papers at national and international level. He has also published two books. Under the guidance of Prof. P.M. Deshmukh, Research Scholar S. D. Mahalle acquired the degree of Acharya. In the Department of Statistics, Prof. Mrs. B . S. Vidhale presented a research paper in the National Conference. Dr. M. B. Gathe from the Department of Geography has presented three research papers in International journals and one research paper in International conference. Prof. Dr. Mrs. A. P. Patil from the same department has also published a book. Head Department of Home Economics Prof. Dr. Mrs. L. B. Hivase has published a research paper in an International journal. Also, a book on diet and food science has been published by her. Handloom cloth bags were distributed with an aim to reduce the use of plastic for environmental balance. Under "Voter Awareness programme" by Department of Social Sciences, voter awareness and E.V.M. Training was provided the students. Prof. Dr. V. S. Bhakre from History department has presented a research paper in a state level conference. Also one of her articles has been published in a book. Head of

Department of English Prof. Mr. P. G. Dindokar published a research paper in the International journal.

From the Department of Mathematics four students from BSC. Part-III participated in the National Workshop and two students from MSc Part-II participated in the Inter-College Seminar Competition. Head of the Maths Department Prof. Dr. V. G. Mete has published ten papers in International journals and presented two papers in national conferences. In this session, a workshop on Mathematical Science for NET/SET examination was organized in association with Department of Post Graduate Mathematics, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati in which 200 participant students were guided. Under the guidance of Dr. Mete ,Prof. Kailash Mule submitted his thesis to the university for the degree of Acharya. In the Department of Zoology, Prof. Dr. Mrs. S.V. Deshmukh has published a research paper in an International research journal. He also presented two papers in national and international conferences. During the Navratri festival, extension programs such as collecting Nirmalya and using it for making Vermicompost, distributing clay pots for bird conservation and guppy fish to control diseases like malaria were implemented by the department. Also Head of Computer Science Department Prof. Mr. S. G. Chaudhary presented a research paper at the National Conference.

By the Department of Physics, Head of the department Prof. Dr. S. V. Jagtap published a research paper in an international research journal and also presented a research paper in an International conference. Department of Chemistry has published fourteen research papers in International journals and organized five research paper collegiate seminar competitions in national and International conferences. Dr. S.D. Thakur presented one research paper in International conference, fourteen research papers were published in International journals by the Department of Chemistry, five research papers were presented in national and international conferences. University level inter college seminar competition was organized by the department.

Department of Botany organized MPSC preparation guidance workshops for the students. Under the extension work programme, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Agriculture workshops were also organized. In the session 2018-2019, Two faculty successfully completed FDP, Short Term Course, Faculty Orientation programme and other courses and in the session 2019-2020, There are 22 faculty completed these programmes successfully.

During the period from 30/09/2019 to 03/10/2019, the students participated in the University Cultural Competition (Yuva Mahotsav) held at Government Vidarbha Institute of

Knowledge and science .Amravati in various forms, among which the students performed remarkably in “Debate Competition”, “Sugam Sangit” and” Rangoli Competition”.

National Conference was organized by the Department of Sports and Physical Education on "Role of Physical Education and Other Disciplines in Enhancing the Performance of Players and fitness for young and new India" in association with College of Arts and Sciences, Kurha and Physical Education Foundation of India on 24th December, 2018.

Dr. Nitin Dhande, President of Vidarbha Youth Welfare Society, Amravati, presided over the inauguration of this conference. Dr. Rajesh Jaipurkar, Vice-Chancellor, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University inaugurated the function, Anandeshwar Pandey, Ashok Kumar Dhyanchand, Dr. Ajay Kumar Bansal, Dr. Piyush Jain and all the dignitaries of the organization were present. There are 294 delegates from across the country including Jammu Kashmir, Delhi, Madhya Pradesh, Tripura, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra participated in the conference. 251 research papers submitted and published on Ayushi international Journal.

In this session in various university sports competitions total of 96 players participated out of which **10 Gold, 7 Silver and 5 Bronze** medals were won and 15 players were selected in the university team for the All India University Tournament.

In the academic session 2019-20, a free athletics camp was organized during the summer vacation from 02.5.2019 to 30.5.2019 in which school and college students aged 8 to 25 years were trained in the basic skills of Running, Jumping and Throwing. There are 74 boys and 58 girls of the college participated in the inter-college competition organized by the university in Malkhamb, Cross Country, Kabaddi, Wrestling, Volleyball, Athletics, Weight Lifting, Cricket, Kho-Kho. It includes 100, 200, 400, 800, 1500, 4x400 meter.

In Athletic (boys) sports like long jump, triple jump got 8 gold. In javelin, 4x400 min. Relay, won 4 silver medals. Similarly, in Athletics (girls) sports, high jump, long jump, 400 m hurdle got 3 **Gold Medals** and in 100 m. huddles received the Bronze Medal. Akshay Ekonkar of this college, [B. Com I] and Ms. Samiksha Uprokar, B. A. Part-2 was awarded the best women player award. HVPM and DCPE College were top achievers in this sport category.

In this year our college won the men's title in this sport is a special addition to the glory of the college. The girls of this college secured the first position in the archery, weight lifting and wrestling sports. So far in the university team for the All India tournament,7 players have been selected in the state level university competition (Ashwamedh). In this

session, a state level workshop on "Athletics - Rules & Regulations" was organized on June 16 and 17, 2019 in which a total of 112 sports teachers participated.

In this session the college organized an inter-college "Cross Country competition" in which 320 boys and 221 girls participated. The Police Commissioner at, Rural Police Department and State Reserve Police Force got the support for this competition. Director of this Department Mr. Atul Patil was awarded the degree of Acharya in the Faculty of Physical Education by Swami Ramanand Tirtha Marathwada Nanded University.

A felicitation program was held on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Padma Bhushan Bar. Ram Rao Annasaheb Deshmukh. On this occasion, all the dignitaries of the organization along with their families and local dignitaries attended the program. A state level intercollegiate debate competition was also organized on the topic "College elections are imperative to prove new political leadership in today's climate!" It was held on this topic on 4th December, 2019. A total number of 38 contestants from across the state were present in it. Mr. Dhiraj Bone from Shivaji College of Arts and Commerce, Amravati, and Pravin Shinde from Tilak Maharashtra university Pune, Akash Patil of D.Y.Patil College, Pune and Aniruddha Mahajan from Tata Institute, Mumbai were given the first, second, third and incentive prizes respectively.

In the year 2019 dated 25th November, 2019 a competition was organized on the topic "Removal of Article 370 was necessary to maintain Peace and order in Kashmir ". 19 contestants participated in it. Contestants Dharmesh Hire from Vidyavardhini College, Dhule, Rasoni College, Karan Parik from Nagpur, Fergusson College, Amol Maslakhamb from Pune and Garware College. , Sanjivani Somase of Pune was awarded first, second, third and incentive prizes respectively.

National Unity Day, Constitution Day, Savitribai Phule Jayanti, International Yoga Day, Tree Plantation from 18th October, 2018 to 26th November, 2019 was conducted by National Service Scheme Team of the college. Under Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan programme, Awareness Workshops, Processions, College and Cleanliness programmes were conducted. Also, a special rural camp was organized at adopted Village, "Hinglaspur Devi" from 4th January 2019 to 11th January 2019.

Alumni Meet was organized on 23 February 2019, there are 85 Alumni participated in this occasion. Also the Alumni Association office bearer meeting for the session 2019-20 was concluded on 15 October 2020: it was decided to organize the gathering in January 2020. In the academic session 2018-19, a total of 286 students of the college created and displayed 151 murals and posters. In the same way in the session 2019-2020, total 267 students have

published 136. Apart from this, on 15th August, 2019, a mural painting and placard competition was organized on the theme "India's Freedom Movement". A total of 34 mural paintings and placards were displayed on the theme. First, second and third incentive prizes were distributed among the participating contestants.
